- ॐ All the women felt as though they were bathed in oil
- ॐ LCM sits and gives food & cloth to all the brahmanas
- ॐ The brahmanas apply candan to LCM
- ॐ BK brings a palanquin
- ॐ N circumambulates SM and then gets on palanquin
- ॐ Procession from N to VP's house
- ॐ Order: infantry then tax collectors then people carrying various colored flags, then jesters dressed in costume
- ॐ Procession goes all through Navadvipa ending at S Misra's house
- ॐ S Misra welcomes son-in-law w/ padya, arghya, acamana, & ornaments
- ॐ Women welcome N w/ durva grass & arati
- ॐ Showers of puffed rice & coins
- ॐ N is blindfolded & VP circumambulates 7x then offers obeisance
- ॐ Musicians play and flowers are thrown
- ॐ VP garlands N
- ॐ N garlands VP
- ॐ Demigods (unseen) shower flowers
- ॐ S Misra offer VP to N along w/ padya, arghya, acamana
- ॐ S Misra then offers cows land, bedding, (maid)servants
- ॐ VP & N switch sides (VP is on left)
- ॐ Agni hotra
- ॐ Afterwards go inside for a meal

**Materialists in Navadvipa**

- ॐ “Those who read Srimad Bhagavatam and Bhagavad Gita never engage in sankirtana.”
- ॐ The devotees would perform kirtan privately by clapping their hands
- ॐ Still others would criticize, “why so loud”
