

Srivasa's Mother-in-law disturbs the kirtan

- ॐ One night LCM stops kirtan
- ॐ “Why tonight not feeling love for K?”
- ॐ Someone who is not supposed to be here, here?
- ॐ Sv: no, it's only your devotees
- ॐ Kirtan begins
- ॐ Again stop
- ॐ LCM: I am not feeling any ecstasy
- ॐ Devotees: We must have committed some offense
- ॐ Sv searches house and finds mother-in-law hiding and became angry
- ॐ Takes her by hair outside house
- ॐ Sv (to LCM): No kirtan should be OK
- ॐ LCM becomes ecstatic
- ॐ Sv becomes ecstatic
- ॐ Mother-in-law was fortunate, but not a pure devotee; wanted to see dancing w/o devotion

LCM adopts the mood of a servant

- ॐ One day LCM stops kirtan
- ॐ “I am not feeling any ecstasy
- ॐ “Have I offended someone?”
- ॐ LCM takes mood of servant
- ॐ “If I even perform mischief please inform me so that I can die immediately”
- ॐ K = life, my dharma
- ॐ I have no other desire than K's seva
- ॐ Help me to understand this so I don't deviate
- ॐ LCM gives permission to touch feet
- ॐ LCM remain in mood of servant
- ॐ When see a dev, LCM would touch his feet
- ॐ Devotees would get in to distress

Advaita steals dust

- ॐ LCM always respected AA as guru, therefore AA never gets to serve directly
- ॐ One day during kirtan at Sv' house LCM falls unconscious
- ॐ AA begins to take dust from LCM's feet and smear on body

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- ॐ When LCM come to kirtan begins
- ॐ LCM stops
- ॐ I do not feel any ecstasy
- ॐ Some one has stolen something from me
- ॐ Devotees silent
- ॐ Did someone take dust from my feet?
- ॐ Devotees silent: say truth offend AA, don't say truth offend LCM
- ॐ AA (understanding dilemma): I stole the dust. What can I say? I am a thief.
- ॐ When someone keeps something valuable tightly locked up, a thief is going to try and steal it.
- ॐ If I have displeased you I wont do it again
- ॐ LCM (angry): Even after annihilating the entire world you are not satisfied. I alone remain after annihilation.
- ॐ When you annihilate Me, then you will be happy. W
- ॐ When you kill even the ascetics, sanniyasis, yogis and renowned philosophers who can remain safe from Your trident?
- ॐ If someone come to achieve Your favor, You grab His feet and kill Him
- ॐ A great devotee from Mathura came to see you
- ॐ He was supposed to achieve devotional service to Visnu by seeing you, but you destroyed whatever strength he had
- ॐ You destroyed him by taking the dust of His feet.
- ॐ You are the most merciless
- ॐ K has endowed you with the devotion found in innumerable universes
- ॐ You steal from an insignificant source.
- ॐ You have no compassion
- ॐ You are the greatest of all thieves
- ॐ Therefore you have stolen My ecstasy
- ॐ You are SPG always taking position as servant
- ॐ You treat me as guru and always take dust from my feet and never allow me to take dust of yours
- ॐ So I saw an opportunity
- ॐ LCM tries to take dust from AA
- ॐ AA can't get a way
- ॐ LCM gets dust
- ॐ LCM: I have robbed the robber

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- ॐ AA: whatever you have said is true
- ॐ By you are a householder, I don't know anything about that
- ॐ My life, intelligence, mind and body all belong to You.
- ॐ If you want to annihilate me, who will protect me?
- ॐ If you want to punish someone who can protect them?
- ॐ When you destroy your own servant, what can he do?
- ॐ Please consider this
- ॐ When you act in this way, it does not increase your glories.
- ॐ This body belongs to you, do with it what you want
- ॐ LCM: You are the storekeeper of devotional service
- ॐ This is why I serve you.
- ॐ If one smears the dust of your lotus feet on his head he will float in the mellows of ecstatic love of K
- ॐ If you do not distribute devotional service, no one can attain it.

Story of Suklambara

- ॐ One day in kirtan: beautiful kirtan
- ॐ Suklambara brahmacari dancing blissfully.
- ॐ No one understood position of Suklambara
- ॐ Would go every day with torn cloth bag and beg
- ॐ People would give the lowest quality things
- ॐ Would go to ten houses/day and beg w/o discrimination
- ॐ Constantly chanting HN
- ॐ So absorbed in ecstasy didn't know what poverty was
- ॐ SB was unseen and unheard by everyone
- ॐ Would come every day to kirtan
- ॐ LCM would watch with happiness
- ॐ LCM calls and reaches hand into SB's begging bag
- ॐ Takes handful in mouth
- ॐ Again
- ॐ Again
- ॐ SB: Now my life is lost
- ॐ This is not fit for you.
- ॐ LCM: never have I tasted such wonderful rice as this from the bag of SB

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- ॐ In previous life you were Sudama Vipra.
- ॐ Whatever you offer gives me the greatest pleasure
- ॐ Gives benediction to always be absorbed in service
