

This necklace is made for Radha-Krishna Deities of Raulkela, a place in Bengal. The deities are about three and a half feet tall. This necklace is 15 inches (37 cms) in length.

Materials required:-

1. Needle.....1
2. Thread.....1
3. Gum.....1
4. Pliers.....1
5. White plastic beads.....360
6. Gold plastic beads.....253
7. Gold beads(medium).....52
8. Gold beads (Small)..... 36
9. Metal plate(6-hole).....16
10. Metal plate(3-hole).....8
11. Small metal rings.....14
12. Plastic hanging beads.....18
13. Metal plate (10-hole)..... 2
14. Metal piece with holes on all side.....4
15. Big central piece.....1
16. Rectangular piece(hole on 2-side).....12
17. Plate with 4-holes.....8



1. Thread the needle and put 15 white beads



1. Put a six hole plate and five gold beads.
2. Thread it through the big pendant



1. Put another five gold beads.



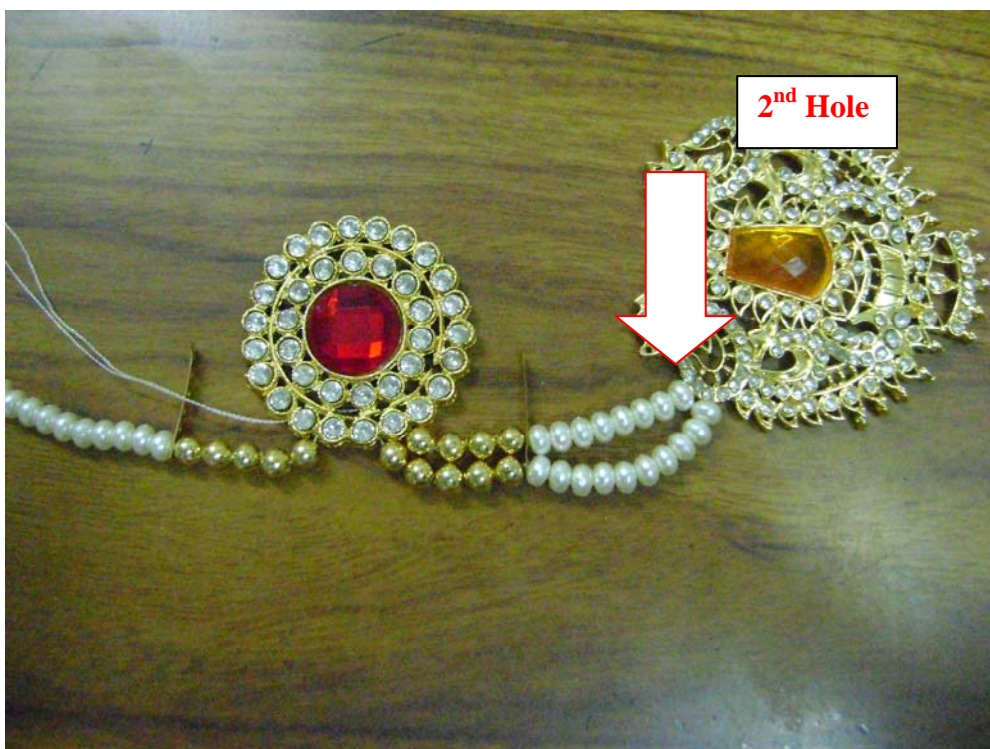
1. Put a plate and another 15 white beads.



1. Put a plate and five gold beads
2. Pass thread through another big pendant
3. Continue by adding another five gold beads



1. Put a plate and then ten white beads
2. Pass thread through the main big yellow pendant and return from next hole.
3. Now put 8 white beads in new line. Add 4 gold beads
4. Pass through the 2nd pendant



1. Now repeat the same for the new line



1. Repeat forming the third line with one gold bead less.

2. Fourth line with one gold bead less . Pass through the big red pendant and follow new picture



1. Put one white bead and the orange rectangle piece.
2. Three small beads to be put in the rectangle piece.
3. Put a white bead.
